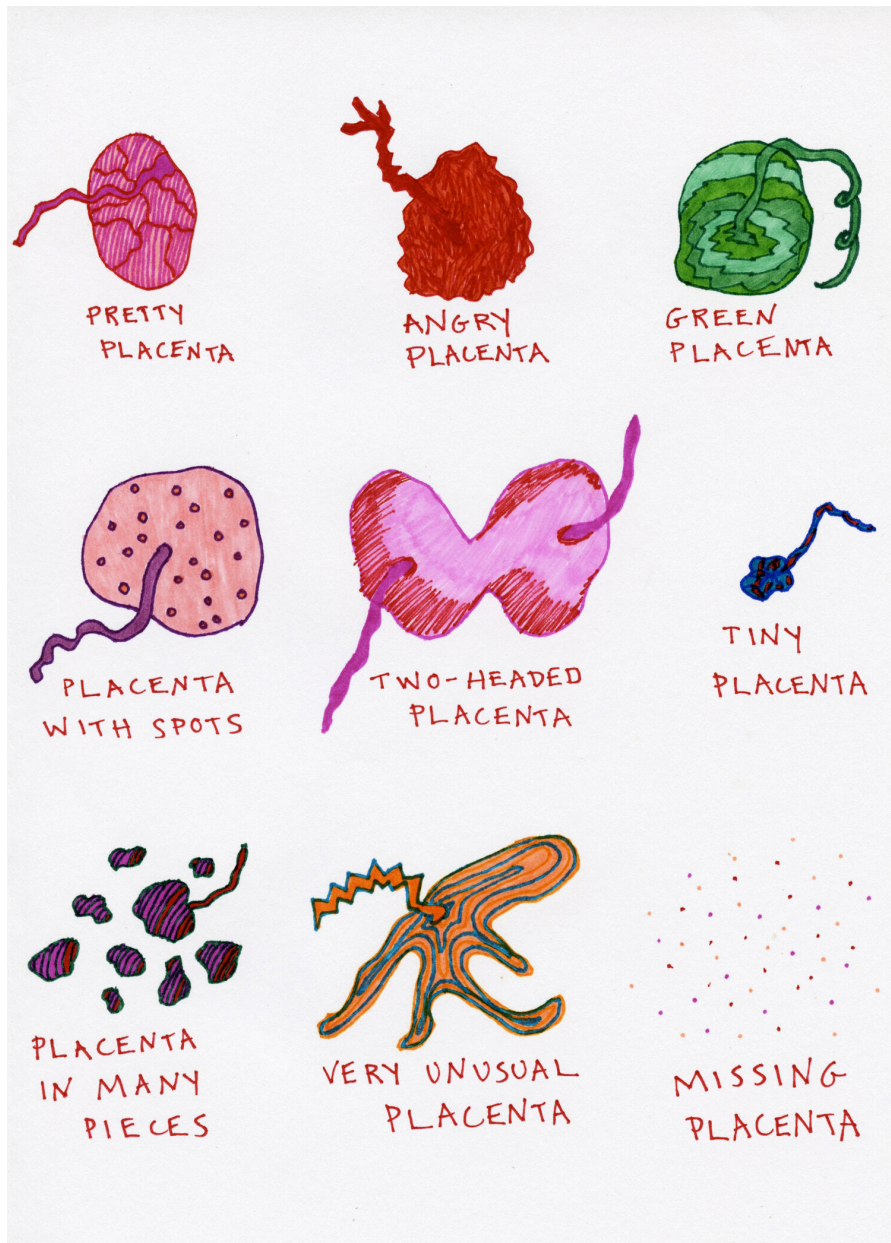


The Ugly Placenta
